JOB DESCRIPTION Spring/Summer, 2020

UW Professional and Continuing Education has an outstanding opportunity for part-time Instructors to teach one or more courses in the [Certificate in UW & Visual Interface Design](#). Beginning in April, 2020 the three 6 week consecutive courses are: [UX Design Thinking](#), [Applied UX Design](#), and [Integrating UX with Interactive Visual Design](#). Classes take place at the UW PCE classroom facility in Bellevue on Tuesday evenings from 6-9pm with two 6 hour Saturday sessions per course.

Requirements: A least five years of professional experience in UX/UI design and/or visual design work for interactive screen based environments. Prior teaching experience is desired but not required.

- Ability to develop lesson plans and presentation materials for 30 hours of instruction. Syllabi and curriculum with learning outcomes currently exist.
- Ability to teach the course on the scheduled dates, respond to student inquiries, be available online for student inquiries and/or office hours. Expectations during the course comprise a minimum of 3 hours of weekly instruction and at least 5 to 8 hours of preparation, student interaction and grading outside of class time.
- Flexibility to adjust to student feedback and a willingness to teach with minimal supervision while maintaining high standards of professionalism, punctuality, and content relevance for adult students in a classroom and/or online environment.
- Ability to interact with individuals from diverse cultural and socioeconomic backgrounds.
- Excellent interpersonal, oral, and written communication skills.
- Legal authorization to work and receive compensation in the United States.
